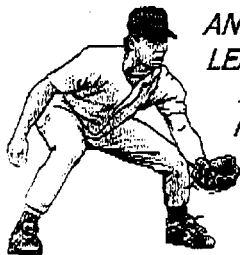




Scout Night Sleepover Policies

The following information is provided for the purpose of making your visit to the Bluefish and Harbor Yard as carefree and enjoyable as possible.

- ✓ Immediately following the game, all scout groups should gather in sections 17 and 19 for a pre-camp briefing
 - After briefing, scouts and chaperones will be allowed to exit the ballpark through the Kid's Cove, bring their cars into Lot A (for gear drop-off) and re-enter the ballpark (gear in hand) through the Kid's Cove.
 - Over night parking is in Lot P
- ✓ Tents with stakes are **NOT** allowed, only pop-up tents are allowed on the field.
 - We ask that if you must use a tarp under your tent that it be no larger than the size of your tent.
 - Please set up tents **ONLY** in the outfield, please stay off of the infield dirt, infield grass and foul territory.
 - Do not enter the dugouts at anytime during the night
- ✓ Fires are **NOT** allowed at any time during the sleepover
- ✓ For security reason, our gate staff may need to look in all bags and backpacks that are brought into the ballpark.
- ✓ Bathrooms are located on the concourse level and are open all night. Please **do not** go to the bathroom on the field.
 - Concourse lights will be left on overnight
- ✓ Alcoholic beverages are **NOT** permitted during the sleepover.
 - If anyone leaves the field during the course of the night, they will not be allowed back onto the field. All gates will be locked once everyone is on the field.
- ✓ No outside food is allowed onto the field. Water **IS** allowed for the sleepover.
- ✓ Please be courteous of all other scouts participating in the sleepover
- ✓ Scouts **MUST** be out of the ballpark by 8:00 a.m. on Saturday



ANYONE CAUGHT VIOLATING ANY OF THE RULES, WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE BALLPARK IMMEDIATELY. IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY, A PHONE IS LOCATED IN THE INFORMATION BOOTH. PICK-UP THE PHONE AND DIAL 311 OR 312 TO CONTACT ONE OF THE MEMBERS OF OUR OVERNIGHT SECURITY TEAM.
